ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY FRIDAY AUGUST 4^{TH} , AT 4:30PM AT CITY HALL 850 Ross Street, Heflin, AL OR AT THE COUNTY FAIR PAGEANT REGISTRATION AT THE ARMORY ON FRIDAY AUGUST 4^{TH} . NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE FAIR.

Rules of Participation:

- Photos may be in color, black and white, or sepia.
- $\bullet \hspace{1.5pt}$ Finished prints must be 5 X 7 or larger but no larger than 18 X 18.
- You may use a film print or digital camera.
- Photos should be simply mounted flat on plain white or black poster board or foam board. Mount board may be no larger than 20 X 20. NO OVAL MATS OR FRAMED PICTURES.
- All entries must be photos taken in Cleburne County.
- All photos must be the original work of the exhibitor.
- Entry Limit 3 entries per person
- Do not have to be a resident of Cleburne County to enter
- Professionals are defined as those that give lessons, have sold their photographs, or who engage in photography as a business or profit.
- Judging will be based on technical quality, composition, and originality. Judges will also factor into account the
 ability to Capture Cleburne.
- Name, address, location of photo and phone number of exhibitor should be printed clearly on the back of each entry.
- Winning Photographs will be featured in the Cleburne News on August 24th and at Cleburne County Chamber of Commerce Building until January 1st 2018
- The management of the Fair and Heflin Arts Council reserves the right to refuse any photograph deemed unsuitable for competition, and all photographs will be displayed at the discretion of the management of the Fair and Arts Council. Entries that do not meet requirements may be disqualified for awards.
- The photographs remain the property of the owner, however, the Fair Committee, Cleburne County Chamber of Commerce, and Heflin Arts Council cannot be held responsible for any loss or damages incurred during exhibition.
